






May 2022 – April 2023





At our first committee meeting, will have everything you need, we will gather at the library*, and our committee will work together to:


- Determine businesses to be visited by assigned committee members (so we don't repeat visits and so business owners will have their familiar contact "Friend".




Tuesday, May 16th at the library




